

**YONKERS RACEWAY TO HOST SIRIUS XM SATELLITE RADIO  
BREEDERS' CUP SHOWS**

YONKERS, NY, Tuesday, October 25, 2011—The Breeders' Cup is right around the corner, and Yonkers Raceway is ready. Yonkers is hosting live Sirius XM Satellite Radio broadcasts both Friday (Nov. 4) and Saturday (Nov. 5), featuring some of the best names in the business.

The shows originate from the Empire Terrace dining room, with air times from 4-8 PM Friday and 10 AM-7:30 PM Saturday. Saturday's Cup broadcast begins with the weekly "Down the Stretch" program.

The shows are co-hosted by legendary race caller Dave Johnson and award-winning racing journalist Bill Finley. For expert analysis, there's none other than Hall of Fame jockey Chris McCarron, winner of nine career Breeders' Cup races, including a record five Classics. Of course, simulcast wagering on the entire Breeders' Cup card—along with all the leading thoroughbred and harness venues—is available throughout the Raceway.

Friday is "Ladies Day" at the Breeders' Cup, with five distaff races among the six Cup events. The Ladies' Classic goes to post at 7:30 PM, and fans can get up-to-the-minute analysis, along with a chance to meet McCarron, Johnson, Finley and handicapper/analyst Darin Zoccali.

Saturday offers eight championship races, with the Breeders' Cup Classic scheduled for 7 PM. Yonkers is also accepting wagers on the two-day, Ladies' Classic/Classic daily double, as well as advance wagering on Saturday's Classic.
